


# Our corona-regulations protect our visitors and staff



We look forward to welcome you to the Kurt Tucholsky Literature Museum. So that we all stay healthy, we observe the protective rules to contain the corona virus and ask for your help. We wish you a good stay at the museum!



In the museum, we pay attention to the minimum distance of 1.5 meters. To ensure this, only 10 visitors can attend the museum at the same time. We can shorten any waiting times for you with offers from our museum shop. The castle and the castle park can also be explored during the waiting times.

Group visits and guided tours are not possible yet..

Of course, we and our visitors wear a medical mask.



At the entrance, in the cash register area and in the museum shop, we protect you and our employees with a plexiglass partition.



At your visit and at events, we ask for your contact details so that we can make the data available to the health department in the event of a corona infection. Each guest receives their own corona form and fills it out with their details. You will then put the form in the box provided. This guarantees data protection. After 2 weeks, we will devestate the forms in compliance with data protection regulations.

In addition, we will provide you with disinfectants at the entrance of the museum. In the stables (go over the bridge and into the elongated building) you can wash your hands for a fee in the public toilet of Rheinsberg Castle.

Depending on the number of visitors, the premises of the Kurt Tucholsky Literature Museum are regularly ventilated. In addition, the museum rooms are disinfected. The interactive exhibits are disinfected by our employees after use.
